The challenge? Getting the show up in 8 weeks instead of the FRC standard of 12. Having to double cast the lead roles (thanks COVID) and finding performers, creatives and crew who were willing to give up their summer to rehearse 2 nights a week and 8 hours on a Saturday. No mean feat. However, overcoming a barrage of blood, sweat, tears (lots of tears) and melt downs, we managed to assemble a Rock Star company of dedicated, talented and positive humans who believed in this project.

This bunch have gone above and beyond to ensure that what you see today has been worth every minute.

Growing up, ABBA was my favorite band. I received their first album as a Christmas gift and I was hooked. The fun, catchy tunes, the harmonies and lyrics, I learned them all...

During my pre-production work on character and story, I very quickly understood how prolific and brilliant songwriters Benny Andersson and Björn Ulvaeus are. The emotional depth of the songs has been connected beautifully to a story written by Catherine Johnson.

The story that is Mamma Mia could be anyone of us. Sophie's quest to find her father may be the main storyline; however, there are many topics throughout that will resonate. I told the cast "the audience doesn't come to see you. They come to see themselves." That is the art of theatre...

As you watch *Mamma Mia!* unfold, I hope you will immerse yourselves in the fictional Greek island of Kalokairi, feel for the characters as they navigate their individual journeys over a 24-hour period at the Summer Night City Taverna. And leave the theatre with a new appreciation...



JUDY CRAYMER (ORIGINAL PRODUCER / CO-CREATOR)

Judy graduated from the Guildhall School of Music in 1977 and has since worked extensively in the theater, film, television and music industries. Judy originated the idea of Mamma Mial and, in 1996, formed Littlestar Services Limited with Benny Andersson, Bjorn Ulvaeus and Richard East to produce the stage musical in London. Since then, she has produced 49 productions of Mamma Mial in 16 languages around the world. In 2002, Judy was presented with a Woman of the Year Award in recognition for her international success with Mamma Mial. In the Queen's birthday honors list of 2007, she was honored with an MBE for her contribution to the music industry. In 2008, Judy produced Mamma Mial The Movie, starring Meryl Streep and Pierce Brosnan. That same year, she was honoured with the Women in Film ITV Achievement of the Year Award. Mamma Mial The Movie was also nominated for a Golden Globe for Best Motion Picture—Musical or Comedy, a BAFTA for Outstanding British film, and Judy was personally nominated by BAFTA for the Carl Foreman Award for Special Achievement. Mamma Mial The Movie is the highest grossing live-action musical film worldwide. In 2010, The Breast Cancer Research Foundation presented Judy with its Humanitarian Award for her commitment to raising breast cancer awareness and research funding around the globe with Mamma Mial and through the sale of the specially created Rock Chick Supremo T-shirts. Following a passion for horses and show jumping, Judy was asked to be an ambassador for British Showjumping, and is proud to support the British Team. Judy is also the producer of Viva Foreverl, an original musical based on the songs of The Spice Girls.



BJÖRN ULVAEUS (MUSIC & LYRICS)

was born in 1945 in Gothenberg on the west coast of Sweden. After a successful local career in Sweden with a folk group in the mid-1960s, he started his collaboration with Benny Andersson. They then went on to form ABBA with Agnetha Faltskog and Anni-Frid Lyngstad. Even during the ABBA years, the idea of writing a musical seemed appealing and, in 1981, Björn and Benny met Tim Rice and co-wrote Chess with him, which opened in the West End in 1986. In 1995 Björn and Benny opened a new musical called Kristina Från Duvemåla, which played for three years in Sweden. Their most recent musical is the Stockholm production Hjälp sökes, which opened in 2013.



BENNY ANDERSSON (MUSIC & LYRICS)

Born in Stockholm on December 16, 1946. Instructed by his father and grandfather, he started to play the accordion at the age of 6, and he has not stopped yet
