


Reefer Madness came into my life about ten years ago when I was going to theatre school in Victoria (living the stereotypical Vancouver island life) and had the incredible privilege of discovering so many new musicals; I was in nerdy theatre kid heaven. A friend of mine showed me the demo recording of the movie musical version starring Alan Cumming, Kristen Bell, and Christian Campbell. I fell in love. The dancing, the music, the satirical nature in which it portrayed fear propaganda at its finest – all lent to this perfectly outrageous musical that I could not get enough of. I had been exposed to the original 1930's REEFER MADNESS propaganda film in my teens and thought the sheer idea of turning it into a campy musical like this one was absolute genius!

When taking on *Reefer Madness* as my first musical to ever direct in its entirety, the thought of the challenging content crossed my mind more than once. Would people want to see a musical about marijuana? What audiences would I be isolating? What audiences would I be enticing? What will the theatre smell like at the end of the night? All of these were questions I had to ask myself. In the end, I decided I wanted to show the city something that has never been done before. I wanted to show them a musical I have always wanted to see live but have never had the chance. *Reefer Madness* not only entertains, but it challenges you to put fear propaganda under a microscope, something that is still entirely prevalent today.

When stepping into the role of director, I immediately decided that this show had enough outrageous and somewhat offensive content that it did not need to be played for shock value. If I can show the audience just how good of a musical it really is regardless of content, I will have succeeded. With the help my insanely talented Choreographer (Jeffrey Diodati), Musical Director (Chelsea Wellman) and cast (whom I could not have done ANY of this without), we were able to create a show that is as genuine as possible. I could not have done this without their support and creative wisdom, and I am eternally grateful. We believe in this musical whole heartedly, and together we have created something great! If you are sitting here reading this, you are likely about to embark on some of the most outrageous, crazy, hilarious, entertaining hours of theatre you have ever witnessed. It's a bold statement I know, but that is how confident and proud I am in the amazing work this cast, crew, and design team have put together for you on this stage. If you are sitting here reading this, you likely saw the title and thought "A show about Marijuana...now that's a show I have to check out" (unless you have no idea what "reefer" is, in which case you may want to google that right now before the show starts...), and I promise it will not disappoint!

The story you are about to witness may shock you...but hopefully you enjoy the ride anyways.


GREGOR SCHOENBERG (GUITAR)
