



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

Grease. You think you know the show, you think you can recite all the lines, but there is GREASE the Movie and then there is Grease the Musical. The movie, like all songs, movies deleted/added deleted/added characters. deleted/added/altered scenes. Most notably, the songs "Grease", "Sandy", "Hopelessly Devoted to You", and "You're the One that I Want" were all created for the movie, and until recently were contractually not allowed to be performed in the stage version. Another interesting change was to the Burger Palace Boys (known as the T-Birds in the film). The movie only really delves into the characters of Danny and Kenickie; Sonny, Doody and Roger are largely ignored. In fact, the character of Roger (aka Rump) was deleted from the film, along with his scenes and songs, and they added the new character of Putzie to fill in gaps in the script. Perhaps the most iconic scene that was added to the movie is the Race at Thunder Row – I meant come on, did you think we could do that on stage?

So for the next 2 hours, I invite you to sit back and revel in the songs and characters you know so well – and discover the equally amazing songs, scenes and characters that are brand new! I would also like to take a moment to thank all the AMAZING individuals who made this show possible. Specifically, a cast who worked their butts off and created characters that make you wish you were part of their gang, a design team who have brought the world of the 1950s and *Grease* to life with so many limitations, and my co-creators (Choreographer, Assistant Director, Stage Manager) – there is not enough gratitude to pass along for your talent and dedication to this show! Please enjoy!

JIM JACOBS (BOOK, MUSIC AND LYRICS)

Jacobs was born and raised on the mean streets of Chicago's far northwest side. During the golden era of rock 'n' roll (1956-1960) he was a guitar-playing "greaser" student at Taft High School. In 1963, Jacobs met Warren Casey when they were both cast in a local theatre production of A Shot in the Dark. Seven years later they wrote what was to become one of the greatest musicals of all time. *Grease* opened in 1971 in a former trolley barn called the Kingston Mines Theatre. He currently resides in Southern California and remains active in the theatre, especially with the American Theatre Company of Chicago.



WARREN CASEY (BOOK, MUSIC AND LYRICS)

Casey was born in Yonkers, New York, and attended Syracuse University. During the late '50s, he learned all about "greasers" while working as an art teacher in upstate NY. He moved to Chicago in 1962, where he hoped to pursue an acting career. He appeared in dozens of productions, including creating the role of Bernie Litko in Mamet's Sexual Perversity in Chicago. He supported himself with jobs in retail, including working as an assistant manager of a chain of apparel stores, and as a record salesman. In the meantime, he taught himself how to play the guitar and began writing songs. Casey died in 1988.



LINDSAY KURTZE (DIRECTOR)

Lindsay has performed/directed and musically directed in over 25 productions in Calgary, Edmonton, and Vancouver. Lindsay holds a BA and BFA from the University of Calgary and a diploma in Musical Theatre from Grant MacEwan University. KRISTINE ASTOP (SET CONSTRUCTION (GREASED LIGHTNING))


